

PCB INVESTIGATION UPDATE for 1/11/2008

We bring you the latest developments in the ongoing investigation and elimination of the PCBs found in the 10 Mile Drainage District and the Lange and Revere Canals.

GOOD NEWS...the contractor hired by the City and the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) will take water and sediment samplings this week in the storms drains along the 10 Mile Drainage District and at the point where the water drains into the canal. The samples will then be analyzed.

This procedure follows the approved MDEQ Work Plan which calls for sampling and assessment in Task #1. The purpose of the sampling is to obtain more relevant information about the PCB impact and ultimately leads into Task #2...the target cleaning of the drains.
