

**CITY OF SAINT CLAIR SHORES  
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The City of Saint Clair Shores will hold a public hearing on the proposed Saint Clair Shores Water Main Replacement Program for the purpose of receiving comments from interested persons.

The hearing will be held at 3:30 p.m. on Monday, April 19, 2010 at the City of Saint Clair Shores Municipal Offices, 27600 Jefferson Circle Drive, Saint Clair Shores, Michigan 48081.

The purpose of the proposed project is to replace water mains within the rights-of-way and utility easements that are beyond their useful service life and experience frequent water main breaks and/or poor water quality. Additionally, water mains proposed for replacement that are undersized will be replaced with a larger pipe to meet current water distribution standards. Project construction will involve replacing sections of deteriorated water mains by means of open cut excavation methods.

Positive impacts of the proposed project include extending the useful service life of the entire water distribution system, restoring the integrity of the water distribution system and decreasing the potential for additional structural deficiencies resulting in additional water main breaks. Negative impacts of the project include short term inconveniences to the general public and an increase in noise and air pollution during construction operations. The estimated cost to users for the proposed project will be approximately five (5) million dollars.
